REGULATIONS REGARDING THE
CONDUCT OF
ALL RIDE-ALONG PASSENGERS

In case of emergency, any rider may be dropped off at any time or place. Emergency contact number must appear on front of form.

No cameras or recorders are permitted, including camera phones.

All females are assigned to a female deputy or accompanied by a second female rider.

Riders are under the control of the deputy during the patrol tour.

Riders are not to leave the patrol car at the scene of police activity without first obtaining permission of the deputy.

Deputy's immediate family members may ride with permission but only once in a ninety (90) day period.
